## How to Make a Smashing CV



- Be Original and Authentic: A great CV will help you stand out
- Make sure it reflects who you are: So the employer can get an idea about yourself
- Give attention to spelling and language: Avoid tired expressions such as passionate, hard working and team player.
- Pay attention to detail: Remember! you will be assessed against others.
- Keep it short: sometimes writing less is more
- Be accurate: don't let others pick out inaccurate information
- Include personal information when necessary: e.g hobbies etc.
- Don't include a photo: unless you are asked to
- Or maybe don't do a CV at all: Have you heard about Video CV?



## **How to Do Well in Interviews**



- Research the organization: Website, social media posts and recent press releases can help.
- Read the job description carefully: Look at specific skills. Bring out examples from your work to align.
- Ask a friend to practice answering questions: Change and modify your answers.
- Plan your interview attire: Wear smart attire.
  Research the company to learn what's appropriate.
- Bring copies of your resume, a notebook and pen: Arrive early.
- Make a great first impression: Display confident body language and a smile throughout.



## How to Do Well in Interviews



- Link your answers to skills and accomplishments: Address the requirements listed in the job description.
- Show authenticity and positivity: Be genuine.
- Respond truthfully to the questions asked: Try not to oversell your skills. Focus on key strengths.





- **Keep answers concise and focused:** Time with each interviewer is limited so don't ramble.
- Do not speak negatively about your previous employers: Companies want to hire problem solvers who overcome tough situations.
- **Ask about next steps**: It is appropriate to ask what you should expect next.
