WITH 41.58 MILLION
CHILD MARRIAGES IN 2023

51 OUT OF EVERY 100 GIRLS
ARE MARRIED OFF BEFORE THEY TURN 18
4 OUT OF 100 BOYS
ARE MARRIED OFF BEFORE THEY TURN 18



AT THE CURRENT RATE, IT WILL TAKE
ANOTHER 300 YEARS UNTIL CHILD MARRIAGE IS ELIMINATED

HOWEVER, THE FUTURE COULD HAVE BEEN DIFFERENT, IF MORE PEOPLE RESPECTED THE SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH RIGHTS (SRHR) OF CHILDREN AND PUT AN END TO CHILD MARRIAGE



A 10% DECREASE IN CHILD MARRIAGES WILL RESULT IN A 76% DECREASE IN THE MATERNAL MORTALITY RATE

THE ESTIMATED ANNUAL BENEFIT FOR LOWER UNDER-FIVE MORTALITY AND MALNUTRITION IS \$98 BILLION BY 2030

ENDING CHILD MARRIAGE AND THE ASSOCIATED SCHOOL DROPOUT RATES WILL

INCREASE GIRLS' CHANCES OF EARNING BETTER WAGES BY 9%
